WEATHER CONDITIONS

The start of 2019 was quite mild and dry, and these conditions led to a premature burst in the vines, leading to fears of a premature year. Early May was marked by a period of frost. Fortunately, rainy weather slowed vegetative growth. Flowering took place at the beginning of June in cool, wet conditions. Summer came slowly, with very hot weather and irregular rainfall. In September, we worried that early water stress might delay the start of ripening, but fortunately the rains came around 20 September, allowing the grapes to finish ripening.



WHITE WINE CHARACTERISTICS

Our white wines are shining, with intense Sauvignon varietal aromas and notes of grapefruit and lemon. Fresh on the palate, they counterbalance the intensity of the ripe Sauvignon aromas.



RED WINE CHARACTERISTICS

The fairly dry weather conditions in August and later in the season meant that the grapes were perfectly ripe, rich in sugar and with great aromatic potential. Our Merlot is intense and deep, with just the right amount of freshness. The Cabernet Franc is well-structured and complex, with great aromatic sparkle.
