WEATHER CONDITIONS

After a 2017 vintage marked by frost, the fear of a similar year is very real. The winter was cool and rainy, resulting in a fairly late budbreak. Unfortunately, a wet spring led to high pressure from cryptogamic diseases. The late summer helped to clean up the vineyards, with dry, sunny weather. Showers fell in August, allowing the grapes to finish maturing. September was dry and sunny, with wide temperature variations favourable to the synthesis of anthocyanins and the degradation of vegetal notes in the wines.



RED WINE CHARACTERISTICS

Our Merlot is expressive, with silky tannins and aromas of ripe cherry. Our Cabernet Franc is also a great success, benefiting from a fine late season that enabled them to be harvested at perfect ripeness.
