WEATHER CONDITIONS

This year, we saw a real inversion of the seasons. We had a foretaste of spring in the winter of 2020, and the mild temperatures allowed the vines to burst early. April was hot and humid with heavy rainstorms, which encouraged rapid twig growth. The vines also flowered early, thanks to summer temperatures in May. The hot weather was followed by a gloomy June with frequent rainfall, which increased the pressure of mildew. Fortunately, the weather changed dramatically in mid-June, when a dry spell set in. From mid-August onwards, heavy thunderstorms broke out again, and September was a month of contrasts.



WHITE WINE CHARACTERISTICS

The dry whites are delicious. Although the summer heat at the start of the year could have led to fears that the wines would lack freshness, the abundant rainfall allowed us to build up a large water reserve, enabling us to produce soft, well-balanced wines.



RED WINE CHARACTERISTICS

The year's climatic conditions undoubtedly affected the regularity of the vine's growth; however, we have seen great success with our red wines, which have shown promise right from the start of ageing. Our wine is colourful, fruity and flavoursome.
